UNIFORM GUIDELINES AND REQUIREMENTS

Below are the range of uniforms required for students at Emmanuel Catholic Primary School.

Parents must support their child to maintain appropriate sizing, fit and length of uniforms:

- Boys' shirts should be of a length that they can be easily tucked in and remain tucked,
- The girls' blouse should be long enough to allow for modesty when arms are raised.

PREP UNIFORM:

Prep students will have an informal uniform that the children will wear everyday, similar to the rest of the school.

It will consist of

- SHIRT: gold polo shirt boys and girls
- SHORTS: boys male sport shorts/ girls female sport shorts
- school sports socks,
- sandshoes.
- Navy Emmanuel school hat
- During the cooler months children may wear navy blue tracksuit pants and the school jumper.

Please ensure that all clothing is clearly marked with names. Even though the children wear aprons for painting activities we cannot guarantee that their clothes will remain clean.



FORMAL UNIFORM:

Worn by students in Years 1-6. Available from Uniform Solutions. It is to be worn on every other day to the Sports Uniform.

- GIRLS:
- Optional Skirt & Blouse / Blue striped dress with back pleat and band, set in sleeve, zippered front, with school emblem. ALL GIRLS MUST HAVE 1 DRESS FOR OFFICIAL SCHOOL OCCASIONS
- Navy tights / navy stockings in winter weather Terms 2 and 3

- Navy Emmanuel school hat
- School pullover or zippered jacket with school emblem



- BOYS:
- Saxe blue shirt with pocket emblem: navy Wash and Wear shorts with longer leg (Stubbies or Ruggers)



- Navy Emmanuel school hat
- School pullover or zippered jacket with school emblem
- Plain navy track suit pants may be worn in winter, Terms 2 and 3 (School shorts to be worn under track pants)

SPORTS UNIFORM:

- BOYS
- Sports shirt with emblem
- Royal blue sports shorts with "EMMANUEL" on leg edge.
- Sports shoes leather or leather look with fabric low cut joggers, WHITE laces, WHITE background, some colour trim is acceptable. Canvas shoes eg. Dunlop Volleys, high cut basketball shoes and white "street" shoes with coloured laces are NOT acceptable. NO "FLURO" COLOURS PLEASE!
- Sports socks white with royal blue and gold stripe
- GIRLS
- Sports shirt with emblem
- Sports shorts
- Sports shoes (leather or leather look with fabric) low cut joggers, WHITE laces,
 WHITE background, some colour trim is acceptable. Canvas shoes eg. Dunlop Volleys,
 high cut basketball shoes and white "street" shoes with coloured laces are NOT acceptable. NO "FLURO" COLOURS PLEASE!
- Sports socks white with royal blue and gold stripe.

<u>Second hand uniforms</u> are available from the school and can be purchased on Tuesday/Thursday afternoons from 2.30pm – 3.00pm. (Cash Only)

FREE DRESS:

On occasion the school will hold free dress days. The following are guides to suitable and safe clothing for these days:

- SHIRTS: Shirts must have sleeves of at least a t-shirt/polo length to cover arms for sun safety
- BOTTOMS: Longs (jeans, pants etc), leggings or shorts can be worn.
- DRESSES: Acceptable
- SHOES: Joggers or school shoes are the only permissible shoes. No thongs, sandals or open toe shoes.
- HATS: Wide brim/bucket hats are allowed no caps.

Please consider how 'short' dresses, shorts or leggings are both for modest reasons and practical reasons (running, PE, play etc.)

SCHOOL HAT:

The only option is our prescribed school hat. This is available for purchase from Uniform Solutions

Hats can be embroided with the child's name, with attention to the following guidelines:

- Name can consist of LAST NAME only or FIRST NAME AND LAST INITIAL eg. SMITH last name only) or ELI H (first name, last initial)
- YELLOW thread in a BLOCK font ALL CAPITALS 10mm high on the CENTRE BACK of the hat
- NO Nicknames

This can be done either through Uniform Solutions or privately, being sure to follow the guidelines.



SHOES AND SOCKS:

All students are to wear black leather or leather look lace up or Velcro joggers, with the following requirements:

SHOES:

- There are to be no additional colours on the shoe, including white piping or lettering. These can be blacked out by the parent with Nico or boot polish;
- The shoe is to be low cut at the ankle;
- There are to be NO Canvas / Volley styles or Mary-Jane styles

NB: At times, students and parents may be given advice from medical professionals regarding footwear. Only at these times and with information provided by a doctor/ medical practitioner should shoes outside of our guidelines be worn. This is at the discretion of the Principal.

HAIRSTYLES

HAIRSTSYLES ARE TO BE APPROPRIATE FOR A PRIMARY SCHOOL STUDENT

Students attending Emmanuel are expected to wear their uniform in a way which reflects pride in their school and in their own personal appearance.

Accordingly,

- Hairstyles should be appropriate to this expectation extreme hairstyles are not acceptable.
- Hair should be clean, brushed and generally neat not unruly.

• NOT PERMITTED:

- o Variations to natural hair colour
- o Cut less than gauge three

- o Boys' hair longer than collar length and fringe past the forehead
- o Spiked cuts
- o Wedge cuts
- o Track cuts
- o Multiple braiding
- o Rat's Tail
- o Mullet Cuts
- If hair bands or scrunchies are to be worn, they are to be gold or blue of the school colours. No decorative hair bands are to be worn.
- NO COLOURED HAIR NATURAL HAIR COLOUR ONLY.

JEWELLERY AT SCHOOL

As per the Uniform List, girls are permitted to only wear **small <u>plain</u> gold or silver sleepers or studs in the lobe of the ear – one pair only**. NO drop earrings are to be worn, in accordance with Workplace, Health & Safety. A small cross and chain around the neck is permitted, preferably long enough to be worn inside the uniform for safety purposes. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings. Rings are not permitted under any circumstances.
